Minutes from regular meeting May 20, 2010

Recommendation: Approval of Minutes as amended.

MOTION: Commissioner Raymond moved to approve the minutes as amended. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Blackwood and the vote was: Ayes: Hawthorne, Hendrix, Blackwood, Raymond, Creighton, Daugherty; The motion carried. Noes: None; Absent: Mosley-Maples.

BUSINESS:

Request to Elect a New Chairman and Vice Chairman for the Traffic Commission.

“The Commission shall elect annual at the first meeting of a new calendar year, from among its members, a chairman, who shall be charged with the orderly conduct of the commission meetings and a vice-chairman to assume such duties in the absence of the chairman.” (Ord. No. CS 911, 10.08.080 AMC)

Commissioner Creighton nominated Commissioner Mosley-Maples for Chairman and the nomination was seconded by Commissioner Raymond. Commissioner Daugherty nominated Raymond for chairperson and the nomination was seconded by Commissioner Blackwood.

Hawthorne called for the vote and the vote was recorded: **3** for Mosley-Maples and **1** vote for Raymond. The Chairman is Mosley-Maples commencing June 17, 2010. The term will expire on December 31, 2010.

Commissioner Creighton nominated Commissioner Raymond and the nomination was seconded by Blackwood. No other nominations were mentioned. The vote was unanimous. The Vice Chairman is Commissioner Raymond commencing June 17, 2010. The term will expire on December 31, 2010.

REPORTS, FOLLOW-UP AND DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Deputy Director of Engineering Len Guillette reported on the Shaffer Road project. Guillette reported the new traffic loops have been placed into the intersection of Shaffer Road and Juniper Avenue and the overlay of rubberized asphalt will begin May 24, 2010. Street striping will follow.

Hawthorne mentioned the request for removal the right turn sign on East Juniper Avenue and Buhach Road has been placed on the City Council agenda.

Sorensen updated the Commissioners on the new signage utilized at the lighted crosswalks.

TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS COMMENTS:

Senior Planner Justin Hendrix expressed his gratitude in serving on the Commission. Due to City Ordinance, his position has been deleted. Hendrix offered his service if needed during future Commission meetings.

Commissioner Daugherty thanked Police Chief Hawthorne for designating a school zone for the Landmark Tabernacle Christian School located on Olive Avenue.
