No action needed due to the City Street Division painted the curbs as part of regular street maintenance.

Request to designate Packers Street to a One Way street, or erect No Parking signs on one side of the street to resolve the narrow clearance and re-stripe existing Loading Zone markings for Memorial Ballpark.

MOTION: *Commissioner Raymond moved to have staff send letters of invitation to all residents located on Packers Street, next to Memorial Ballpark, inviting them to the next Traffic Commission meeting, for the purpose of obtaining input on any possible changes. The motion was seconded by Warchol and the vote was: Ayes: Hendrix, Blackwood, Raymond and Warchol; Noes: None Absent: Mosley-Maples. The motion carried.*

Request discussion and possible resolve of conflicting speed limit signs on Fruitland Avenue.

MOTION: *Commissioner Warchol moved to direct staff to find out the distance limits from curves for advisory signs and correct sign placement if possible. The motion was seconded by Raymond and the vote was: Ayes: Pietro, Hendrix, Blackwood, Raymond and Warchol; Noes: None. Absent: Mosley-Maples. The motion carried.*

Request for a stop sign on Linden Street at the intersection of Palm Avenue.

MOTION: *Commissioner Raymond moved to deny request. The motion was seconded by Warchol and the vote was: Ayes: Pietro, Hendrix, Blackwood, Raymond and Warchol; Noes: None. Absent: Mosley-Maples. The motion carried.*
