

Lifeguard: \$10.50 - \$11.00/hr. The City of Atwater is recruiting for a temporary part-time seasonal hourly position, mainly during the summer months. This position is responsible for the safety of swimmers and enforcement of regulations at the pool; assists classes in phases of swimming, diving, and other aquatic activities to diverse age groups. Maintains discipline in and around swimming pool to prevent accidents; conducts rescue operations; administers CPR and first aid, performs light custodial maintenance techniques, maintains pool water chemistry, maintains and submits reports and records as required; attends staff meetings and training sessions as required; and provides reliable customer service. Incumbents in this classification may be required to work nights, weekends and holidays depending on the recreational activities. FLSA Status: Non-exempt.

Minimum qualifications: Candidates are required to: be enrolled in high school or possess a high school diploma or recognized equivalent, have completed lifeguard training, first aid methods and procedures, and standard first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Must be able to provide a work permit if necessary.

Upon issuance of a conditional job offer, qualifying candidates, age 18 and over, are required to successfully complete and pass a criminal record background clearance, medical examination, and drug screen. Not required for qualifying candidates under the age of 18.
