February 21, 2019

SPECIAL SESSION CALL TO ORDER: (Council Chambers)

The City Council of the City of Atwater met in Special Session this date at 5:23 PM in the City Council Chambers located at the Atwater Civic Center, 750 Bellevue Road, Atwater, California; Mayor Creighton presiding.

COMMISSION MEMBER APPOINTMENTS:

Appointment of three (3) Commissioner Members to the scheduled vacancies on the City of Atwater Community Development and Resources Commission, for a limited term to be determined by the City Council, but not later than December 2019.

The motion was seconded by City Council Member Ambriz and the vote was: Ayes: Ambriz, Cale, Vierra, Creighton; Noes: None; Absent: None. Mayor Pro Tem Raymond recused himself from the vote. The motion passed.
