NOTICE TO BIDDERS

1. Is Option 2 -Electrical and Lights still required?

The City of Atwater is removing Option 2 Electrical and Lights from Bid Call 704-20, Water Tower Recoating/Renovations Project and Exhibit C-Scope of Work for Option 2-Lights and Electrical from Bid Call No. 704-20, Water Tower Recoating/Renovations Project.

2. Want to confirm that the cell carrier satellites and cables will be 100% taken down prior to start this project.

Yes, the cell carrier will take down the antennas and cables prior to the start of this Project.

3. Confirm Engineers Estimate at \$2M.

Yes, this is confirmed, and the Project has the available funding.

4. How many working days do we get to perform the work?

120 Calendar days, this can be negotiated some during the finalizing of the Construction Services Agreement.

5. What is the anticipated start date?

The anticipated start date is early April 2021.

6. Is there a third-party inspection firm?


Yes, there will be a third-party inspection firm. The City is in the process of hiring the firm.

7. Any substitution for paint?

The products mentioned in the specifications are set up as standards of quality. The term "or equal" shall apply to any specification that lists a specific product by brand or trade name. No substitution to any product identified in the specifications will be considered unless a written request for approval has been received by the Owner at least 10 calendar days prior to the date of bid opening. Each such request shall include the name of the specified material for which a substitute is being requested; the name of the proposed substitute material; and a complete description of the proposed substitute including performance and test data and any other information necessary for a proper evaluation. The burden of proof for demonstrating that a proposed substitute is equal to a specified product shall be upon the proposer. The decision of the City regarding approval or rejection of any proposed substitution shall be final.
