ACTION MINUTES

January 10, 2022

CALL TO ORDER:

The City Council of the City of Atwater met in Special Session this date at 4:30 PM in the City Council Chambers located at the Atwater Civic Center, 750 Bellevue Road, Atwater, California and on Zoom; Mayor Creighton presiding.

Mayor Creighton resumed the meeting at 4:51 PM.


By consensus the City Council, by roll call vote, nominated one candidate to fill the scheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission.

MOTION: Mayor Creighton moved to appoint candidate Theron S. Sanders Sr. to the Planning Commission for the term of four (4) years, ending December 31, 2025. The motion was seconded by City Council Member Raymond and the vote was: Ayes: Raymond, Creighton; Noes: Cale, Button; Absent: Ambriz. The motion failed.

MOTION: Mayor Pro Tem Cale moved to appoint candidate Harold Kadach to the Planning Commission for the term of four (4) years, ending December 31, 2025. The motion was seconded by City Council Member Button and the vote was: Ayes: Cale, Raymond, Button, Creighton; Noes: None; Absent: Ambriz. The motion passed.
