City Manager Announces Resignation Effective June 25

Atwater, CA - City Manager Chris Hoem has announced his resignation, effective June 25, 2026, concluding two years of service to the City.

"It has been a tremendous privilege to serve this community," said Hoem. "I am grateful for the opportunity to work alongside dedicated staff, elected officials, and residents who care deeply about the future of the city."

During his tenure, the City adopted its 2026–2030 Strategic Plan, establishing a shared vision and priorities for the years ahead. The City also recently adopted a budget that includes a structural General Fund surplus, strengthening the organization's long-term fiscal position.

Mayor Mike Nelson thanked Hoem for his service and contributions to the City.

"On behalf of the City Council, I want to thank Chris for his service to our community over the past two years," said Mayor Nelson. "Local government is a team effort, and we are grateful for his partnership with the City Council, staff, and community. We wish him continued success in the future."

The City Council will meet soon to discuss next steps regarding interim leadership and the recruitment of a new City Manager.
